Sunny Corner Wind Farm Community
Update – 19 February 2026

Hi everyone,

We are pleased to share an update on new opportunities for local businesses, as local engagement and planning continues regarding the proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm.

Local business opportunities now open

Someva Renewables and Mainstream Renewable Power are calling on local businesses to submit Expressions of Interest in participating in the development of the proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm.

Twenty-five (25) work packages have now been released via the online Industry Capability Network (ICN) Gateway portal, with opportunities for businesses specialising in:

- Earthworks and concreting
- Fencing, construction and steelworks
- Electrical services and logistics
- Crane operations and shuttle bus services
- Cleaning, catering and temporary accommodation provision

The proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm is committed to working with as many local suppliers and contractors as possible. If approved and constructed, the project is expected to generate approximately 475 jobs during construction and around 35 full-time roles during operation, with significant flow-on benefits for local suppliers, accommodation providers and hospitality businesses.

If approved, construction on the Sunny Corner Wind Farm is expected to commence in 2028.

Local businesses are encouraged to register their interest before the December 2026 deadline. This will assist us in developing a local procurement strategy aimed at supporting as many local jobs and businesses as possible, should the proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm be approved.

Reminder: Near Neighbour Program closing soon

A quick reminder that the proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm Near Neighbour Program closes at 5pm on 28 February 2026.

The project team is continuing outreach to eligible near neighbours, with nearly two-thirds of eligible landowners already in active conversation with the project team.

The proposed Sunny Corner Wind Farm's Near Neighbour Program is open to eligible landowners in Sunny Corner, Dark Corner, Yetholme and Meadow Flat, and rural properties within 2.5km of a proposed wind turbine.

It is designed to share benefits with landowners living closest to proposed wind turbines. For example, someone living about 2km from a turbine with a moderate view of the wind farm could receive around \$9,500 a year each year for 32 years (\$304,000).

If you think you may be eligible, or know someone who might be, we encourage you to contact the project team before the Program closes.

We want every eligible neighbour to have the opportunity to understand the Program and share in the benefits from the proposed wind farm. To participate, eligible neighbours need to sign a Neighbour Benefit Sharing Deed by the closing date of 5pm, 28 February 2026.
